

Decisions of the 01.087th Meeting of the Central Council of the Pharmacy Council of India held on 25th & 26th February, 2011 at Coimbatore.

1. All decisions where Council has granted final approval u/s 12 for the purpose of registration as a pharmacist have been updated on Council's website under the list of approved Diploma & Degree institutions.
2. All decisions where Council has granted approval for conduct of course only have been updated on Council's website under the list of Diploma, Degree and Pharm.D. institutions.
3. Council's decision not to make admissions, stop admissions, notice u/s 13, withdrawal u/s 13 etc. have also been uploaded on these lists.
4. Other decisions are as under -

1. Approval of the Diploma course and examination in Pharmacy conducted at Guru Teg Bahadar Khalsa College of Pharmacy, Chhapian Wali-Malout, Dist. Muktsar (Punjab) in the light of 2nd (surprise) Inspection Report (November, 2010)
