Subject: Strengthening Compliance with UGC Anti-Ragging Regulations and Monitoring Mechanisms

The University Grants Commission (UGC) remains committed to ensuring a safe and conducive learning environment in all Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs). It has been a year since UGC issued its notification mandating the implementation of robust anti-ragging mechanisms, including the Mentor-Mentee system, legal counsel support, institutional accountability, and surprise compliance checks.

As part of a structured review, UGC now seeks:

- Compliance Verification: HEIs and Regulatory Bodies are requested to submit reports
 detailing the implementation status of the UGC guidelines at email. raggingcell@yahoo.in.
 These reports should highlight institutional efforts to prevent ragging, including awareness
 drives, disciplinary measures, and proactive engagement with students.
- 2. Strengthened Monitoring Measures: All Regulatory Councils and Monitoring Agencies must streamline anti-ragging compliance checks, enhance surprise inspections, and ensure strict enforcement of preventive policies within educational institutions.
- 3. **Inter-Council Coordination:** To enhance enforcement, UGC invites AICTE, NMC, INC, and other relevant bodies to collaborate on compliance reviews and institutional inspections. A meeting to coordinate further action will be scheduled soon.

We urge all recipients to provide a detailed status report by 1st June, 2025 to ensure timely and effective implementation of anti-ragging measures.
