Sub: Final Reminder for the Implementation of AEBAS as per Gazette Notification issued by the Government of India for Applications received from Pharmacy Institutions seeking Approval for the Academic Session 2026–2027.

Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to the multiple email and circulars published by the council along with the repetitive extensions for the implementation of AEBAS across all pharmacy institutions.

In order to assist various institutions for the smooth onboarding and implementation, council has organised continuous workshops across the multiple states to ensure the clarity on the procedures, technical steps and expectations of the council.

However, the implementation of the AEBAS with complete steps i.e. registration of institutions, onboarding of faculty on the AEBAS portal, regular attendance marking etc. are not being done by the institutions as directed by the council time to time.

As on date only 50% (approx.) of the faculty registered on the DIGI-Pharmed portal are not registered and initiated marking attendance on regular basis which may lead to the blocking of their user profile post expiry of the deadline as informed by council vide circular dated 04.05.2026.

Therefore, council directs all pharmacy institutions with this circular as a final reminder for the complete implementation of AEBAS **within 21 days** from the issuance of this circular.

In case of any technical issues, all institutions are directed to raise the grievance through this URL <https://digipharmed.pci.gov.in/#/login-issue> instead of any telephonic communication/email reminder.

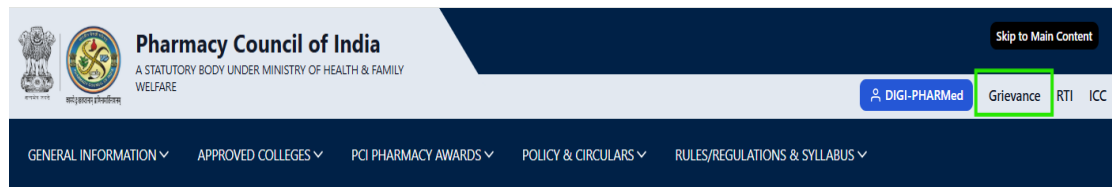


Figure 1: Grievance Submission Icon can be viewed as highlighted above on PCI.GOV.IN

Further, institutions must ensure the following while raising grievance as under:

- It is requested to visit the grievance portal <https://digipharmed.pci.gov.in/#/loginissue> and select the department as “IT” to submit the grievance citing the issues related to the AEBAS from the dropdown in Issues Type.
- Institutions must type their PCI Code as: PCI-1234 instead of 1234 only.
- All request should be submitted on the grievance portal only.
- Institutions must refer to the various user manual available in FAQ section on <https://central.pci.ac.in/>
