Sub: Final Reminder regarding mandatory registration of Institutions and Faculty on AEBAS Portal for compliance in all PCI approved pharmacy institutions.

Sir/Madam,

- This has reference to the above cited subject matter and previous circulars issued by the Council regarding implementation of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS) across all PCI approved pharmacy institutions.
- In continuation to the same, it has been observed that several institutions have not yet completed their registration/onboarding on the AEBAS portal of Pharmacy Council of India (<https://central.pci.ac.in>), despite multiple advisories and facilitation workshops conducted by the Council across the nation.
- As per the last circular dated, 20.02.2026, the last day for implementing AEBAS was 01.03.2026 in order to be compliant. However, based on the review of the status of all institutions regarding the implementation of AEBAS, council has observed the following as under:

- a. Institutions has onboarded themselves on the AEBAS but no faculty members are onboarded on the portal.
 - b. Institutions has onboarded themselves on the AEBAS but no devices have been connected and linked to the institution's profile.
 - c. Faculty Members are registered on the institution's portal but not marking attendance on the AEBAS.
 - d. Faculty members are marking attendance on irregular basis and not complying with the directions of the council.
4. In view of the above, all stakeholders are hereby directed to ensure completion of the following within a period of 7 (seven) days from the date of issuance of this circular:
- o Successful onboarding/registration of the institution on the AEBAS portal.
 - o Appointment and verification of Nodal Officer.
 - o Registration and approval of all faculty members on the AEBAS platform.
 - o Initiation of attendance marking through the biometric system.
5. It is hereby strictly notified that failure to comply within the stipulated timeline shall attract strict action.
6. Institutions are advised to ensure that all their faculty members are onboarded and marking attendance regularly.
7. All approved faculty on the DIGI-Pharmed portal must ensure that their attendance is being marked on the AEBAS portal within maximum of 7/15/21 days from the publish of this circular.
8. Failure to compliance with these directions will lead to the blocking of their individual Pharmacists Profile due to the non-verification and Updation of Aadhaar enabled verification aimed by council.
9. Further, it is reiterated that all queries/issues related to AEBAS implementation must be submitted through the designated grievance portal only.
