Sub-Compliance of order dt.9.5.2024 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Judicature of Bombay Bench at Aurangabad in W.P.No.4922 of 2024 and any other connected matter.

Council's Circular No.464 PCI-17-115/2019-PCI (Maharashtra Lead File) dt.9.7.2024. Ref.No. -

Sir/Madam.

This is in superannuation to Council's circular dt.9.7.2024.

In this connection -

(a) It is informed that the order dt.9.5.2024 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Judicature of Bombay Bench at Aurangabad in W.P.No.4922 of 2024 filed by Sant Dnyaneshware Bahuuddeshiva Sevabhavi and any other connected matter, was placed before the 409th EC of the PCI held on 6.6.2024, which decided as under: -

Consideration of order dt.9.5.2024 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Judicature of Bombay Bench at Aurangabad in W.P. No.4922 of 2024 filed by Sant Dnyaneshwar Bahuuddeshiya Sevabhavi Sanstha Vs. State of Maharashtra.

- 45.1 It was directly taken up.
- It was noted that Hon'ble High Court of Judicature of Bombay Bench at Aurangabad vide its order dt.9.5.2024 in W.P. No.4922 of 2024 filed by Sant Dnyaneshwar Bahuuddeshiya Sevabhavi Sanstha Vs. State of Maharashtra decided to stay the implementation and effect of decision dt.12.2.2024 taken by Pharmacy Council of India. Further PCI is directed to consider the applications of the institutions.
- 45.3 In compliance of above-mentioned order, it was decided that the PCI does not have any difficulty in processing the application of the institutions if the institutions submit the complete statutory documents (Consent of Affiliation of Examining Authority and NOC of the State Government) required by the PCI.
- 45.4 It was further decided that PCI office shall convey the aforesaid decision of the PCI to the concerned authorities and institutions.
- 45.5 It was also decided to take action in anticipation of comments from the EC members on the EC minutes.

- (b) It is reiterated that any prospective institution which intends to conduct a course of study for pharmacists has to apply to the PCI for approval of the course and examination. The institution has to submit Standard Inspection Form (SIF) as per the requirement of Education Regulations (ER) alongwith Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges (PERC).
- (c) On receipt of complete documents i.e. Consent of Examining Authority and No Objection Certificate (NOC) of the State Government, the Council will arrange inspection to verify the facilities as claimed in the Standard Inspection Form (SIF) by the institution.

In view of above, it is informed that if the Statutory Documents are complete, the Council will arrange the inspection very soon. Further the institutions who have not submitted the Statutory Document, kindly submit on or before 31st July 2024 positively.

This is for strict compliance and necessary action.
