

Minutes of Emergency 02.416th Executive Committee (EC) meeting of the Council held on 20th & 21st September, 2024 at New Delhi.

02.416.007: Consideration of findings of PHC Committee in respect of unapproved batches on PHC scheduled on 12.8.2024.

- 8.2 It was decided to approve the recommendation of the PHC meeting dt.12.8.2024.
- 8.3 Regarding B.D.M.International Pharmacy School Gram Pandypur, ShahadatpurGosaiganj, Dist Sultanpur 228119 UP (D.Pharm) (PCI-8028).

1. The PHC noted that -

- a) Infrastructure – Original documents of land building plan approved by competent authority is not submitted.
- b) Laboratories and other infrastructural facilities are not furnished. No furniture and fixture are shown in the video. No doors and windows seen.
- c) Teaching Staff- Teacher accepted that they are visiting . They don't have knowledge of subject. Accepted that they have not conducted any practical class of students and don't have any facilities for conduct of practical classes.
- d) Details of Equipments - No Authentic documents submitted. Photocopy of Bills submitted.

Photocopy without attestation submitted regarding purchase of equipments, chemicals, glassware and furniture –

Remarks on complaints - Found True

Recommendation of PHC : As the college is not comply the norms as prescribed in the regulation. Action as per provision of section13 of the Pharmacy Acts, 1948 is recommended.

2. In view of above, the findings of PHC dt.12.8.2024 were placed before the Executive Committee meeting and it was decided that notice u/s 13 be issued to the institution as the institution is not complying with the prescribed norms as per regulations of PCI.

8.4 Regarding Chityaranjan College Of Pharmacy, Bharila, Dinajpur Dakshin-733102 (WestBengal) (PCI-5679).

1. The findings of PHC dt.12.8.2024 were placed before the Executive Committee meeting.
2. It was noted that –
 - a) The college denied the inspection committee of the council to enter in the campus & to inspect the college. The video recording of the incident was submitted to PHC by inspectors. The college representative accepted that they have not allowed inspectors to enter in the premises. The excuse given by the college is not accepted by PHC.
 - b) Considering seriousness of matter and dishonor of Council's order. The PHC recommended that the college be imposed fine for their misbehavior & be re-inspected with their cost for which the college should pay Rs. 5,00,000/- (Five Lakhs) in advance to the Council till the report of re-inspection & take action on it, the approval of college for year 2024-2025 be kept in abeyance.
3. In view of above, it was decided to arrange inspection as recommended by inspection committee and instruct the institution to submit inspection cost of Rs.5 lakh in advance before inspection.

8.5 Regarding ANP Pharmacist College of Pharmacy, RAJAPUR (West Bengal) (PCI-8490).

1. It was noted that the inspection committee mentioned in the report that the college denied the inspectors to visit & verify the facilities while the college representation say is different.
2. Under such circumstances, its difficult for PHC to comment on the issue. While the PHC recommend that the college be visited again and verify the facilities of the issues raised in complaint at the cost of college. The college be asked to pay Rs.1,00,000 (One Lakh) in advance to the Council for conduction of re-inspection till that time approval for year 2024-25 should not be issued.

3. In view of above, it was decided to arrange inspection as recommended by inspection committee and instruct the institution to submit inspection cost of Rs.1 lakh in advance before inspection.

8.6 Imperial Institute of Pharmacy, Senai-712611 (West Bengal) (PCI-7254).

1. It was noted that -

- a) The college denied appear before PHC for two times i.e. first on dated 24.04.2024 for which Council have not received any reply & second time on today i.e. 12.8.2024 for which the college sent mail stating that due to internal exam they can't appear before PHC.
- b) The college has given fulfilled chances to the college for appeal before PHC. Still not responded which the PHC feels that misconduct & dishonour of Council's order.
- c) The PHC recommend that as college is not following Council order action may be taken against the college as per provision of Section 13 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948.

2. In view of above, the findings of PHC dt.12.8.2024 were placed before the Executive Committee meeting and it was decided that notice u/s 13 be issued to the institution as the institution is not complying with the prescribed norms as per regulations of PCI.

b) Accordingly Facts Finding Committee were deputed for Surprise Inspection, findings is as under:-

- The Committee visited the Institution on 4.12.2023 and observed that Institute is running Adarsh Institute of Pharmacy at 543, Azamshah Layout, Nagpur.
1. The institute got approval from PCI Id – 7988 to run the B.Pharm and D.Pharm course with reference to points raised in the observation are as following –
 - a. The SatchikitsaPrasarak Mandal has applied for new Pharmacy institute in the premises where “**Homeopathic College**” was running. The affiliation of the Homeopathic institute was withdrawn by the affiliating University i.e., Maharashtra University of Health Science vide letter No. 540/2013 dated 1.4.2013. Further, the permanent closure of the institution has been notified by Govt. Of Maharashtra dated 20.4.2023.
 - b. The college has submitted an undertaking that approval of charity commissioner is not required, however, the legal opinion in this matter may be sought.
 - c. The college got approval for D.Pharm program with PCI ID – 7370 from PCI dated 4.5.02023. The college has submitted the request for merger of both the institute i.e., PCI – 7988 and PCI – 7370 through letter No. AIP/08/2022-23 dated 14.2.2023. Further, The Institute submitted the copy of information available on MSBTE portal, where no admission data is available. The copy of same has been submitted to DTE vide letter No. SPM/51/2023-24 dated 4.11.2023.
 - d. The NOC from the state Government, Board of technical Education & approval of D.Pharm course.
 - e. The college has provided the list of 26 students admitted during 2022-2023, who were transferred to other college as per the orders of Hon’ble Supreme Court of India & Department of Technical Education.
 - f. The resolution of society for start of B.Pharm and D.Pharm course.
 - g. The college has purchased the books, equipments, Chemical & Glassware.
 - h. The college has submitted the documents supporting that the dues of Dr. Gopal has been settled by paying the amount of Rs.10,18,614/-.
 - i. The list of admitted students during the session 2023-2024.
 - j. The inspection reports submitted by the College.
 - k. The copies of various court orders.
 - l. The college has given and undertaking that no court case is pending against Homeopathy College, regarding no receipt of grant for Homeopathy College & no other school/Institution is being run of this path of land.
 - m. The infrastructural facilities at the institution was verified by the Committee during the visit and also interested with students. The

photographs and video pendriveis also enclosed with the report for reference.

Since the matter includes technical and legal implication, the legal opinion is this regard may be sought by the Council.

- c) Legal opinion was sought from Council's advocate Shri Ajay Kumar. The advocate opined as under –

It's to inform you that the PCI is not required to do anything in reference to the Adarsh Institute of Pharmacyright now. If the college has done anything wrong for getting NOC from the State or Examination Body then The State or Examination Body should have to take steps first. And on the recommendation of the State Government or Examination Body, PCI May proceed further with any decision.

- d) The State Govt. and Examining Authority (Baba Saheb Ambedkar University) as already granted affiliation / approval for 2023-2024 academic session.

9.3 In view of above, it was decided to –

a) **D.Pharm**

- i) Grant approval for 2024-2025 academic session for conduct of 2nd year for D.Pharm course.
- ii) Allow 60 admissions in 2024-2025 in 1st year (D.Pharm).

b) **B.Pharm**

- ii) Allow 60 admissions in 2024-2025 in 1st year (B.Pharm).

- b) arrange surprise inspection by deputing one PCI member and two PCI inspectors.

38.4 It was further decided to take action in anticipation of approval of the minutes from Hon'ble President, PCI.

b) Accordingly, the PCI vide letter dt.18.4.2024 provided login ID and password to Hyatt Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research under Green Valley Educational Trust and Research Centre, NH-44, Lethpora, Pampore, Pulwama – 192121 to enrol the admitted students during 2020-2021 to 2022-2023 admitted batch and also informed the institution regarding the same.

c) The PCI has also not allowed the Hyatt Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research under Green Valley Educational Trust and Research Centre, NH-44, Lethpora, Pampore, Pulwama – 192121 to fill the SIF for 2024-2025 academic session as the matter was sub-judice before the Hon'ble High Court of Jammu & Kashmir.

d) Further, the PCI arranged the surprise inspection on 5.8.2024 and the findings of the Inspection Report is as under-

1. Teaching staff nil.
2. Only 3 labs available without preparation room.
3. 2 labs deficient as per norms.
4. Labs area not as per norms.
5. Gas connection and exhaust fan not available in the lab.
6. Fuming chamber not available in the chemistry lab.
7. Nomenclature of labs display on labs are non-pharmacy subjects.
8. One of the labs not having working slab.
9. Only 10 instruments available in all labs.
10. Books display on library not related to pharmacy, they belong to B.ed.
11. Lab required area facilities other infrastructure are not found as per norms.
12. Academic staff and lab staff not available at the time of inspection.
13. Students are not found available.
14. Accession registers not found in library.
15. Stock registers of chemical and glassware not shown.
16. Copy of building plan and map showing non-pharmacy subject.
17. Very small display of college name on flex only.
18. Attendance register of teaching and non-teaching staff not available.
19. Government of Medical College, Jammu/Srinagar granted affiliation for 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 academic session for 60 seats for D. Pharm course only.

e) The institution has handed over the letter dt. 5.8.2024 to the inspection team of the PCI stating as under-

“We would like to update you that on 3.7.2024, Respected Pratima Ma’am shared the new and correct user ID of our Institute Hyatt Institute of Pharmaceutical Education & Research under Green Valley Educational Trust & Research Centre. However, when we tried to login with new Id provided by the PCI i.e., Hiper.Lethpora@gmail.com, we found that no information of our institution is added there. It is a blank portal which is being provided to new

institution wherein they have to register themselves. We already have the PCI code under PCI-5241 which is registered, so we request your respected office to update the already filled completed data of PCI-5241 under the id: hiper.lethpora@gmail.com which is being already provided to us.”

Shri Ajay Kumar Singh informed that The Pharmacy Council of India in its decision on 30.11.2023 has considered all pending applications with or without deficiency in terms of order dated 29.11.2023 of Hon'ble Delhi High Court in Cont. Case 1705 of 2023 and other connected matters whereby the Hon'ble Court had directed the Pharmacy Council of India to grant the approval to all institutions whose applications are pending for approval, though their deficiencies were communicated or not, subject to such institutions submitting an affidavit in 2 days with an undertaking to remove their respective deficiencies, if any, within a period of 7 days thereafter.
3. The Hon'ble President, PCI directed to take action in the light of the legal opinion received from Shri Ajay Kumar Singh.
4. Accordingly, the Council took the action with the approval of the Competent Authority.
