Sub: Clarification regarding AEBAS Implementation in all PCI Approved pharmacy institutions.

Sir/Madam,

- This has a reference to the above cited subject matter and Council's latest circular no. 14-264/2020-Faculty Module/5789 dated 07.02.2025 regarding implementation of AEBAS in all Pharmacy Approved Institutions.
- In this connection, it is informed that all institutions need to purchase the AEBAS device as per the requirement and guidelines cited in Council's circular No. 5556 dated 24.01.2025 within the stipulated time to enable smooth implementation for the AEBAS across all institutions.
- Institutions must ensure that the device being purchased should be whitelisted on the UIDAI servers for Aadhar authentication of the users through the device.
- All institutions must upload the details regarding AEBAS device on the DIGI-PHARMed Portal (<https://digipharmed.pci.gov.in/#/pci/aebas-details>) in the AEBAS section for the strict compliance.

5. It is also informed that Council will release further guidelines regarding onboarding/registration of all institutions on the Central portal of Pharmacy Council of India within this month.
6. The onboarding process will involve publishing of domain URL for the registration platform, onboarding steps, process for the approval of institutions on the portal etc. Therefore, institutions must not initiate the onboarding request on any other web portal or schemes.
